

Need help paying for child care?

Who Is Eligible?

- A single parent working at least 60 hours per month, or 40 hours per month if you are attending school full-time, or
- Two parent families working at least 120 hours per month between both parents.
- Families with monthly gross income that does not exceed:

Family of 2: \$1,604

3: \$2,011

4: \$2,419

5: \$2,826

6: \$3,234

7: \$3,641

What is Covered?

- Work hours when no parent is available to care for the children.
- School or training hours, not to exceed a bachelor's degree. School hours covered only when the work hours requirement is also met.
- Teen parents attending high school (work hours not required).
- Parents are required to pay a portion of their child care, which is called a co-payment. The amount of the co-payment is based on the family's income.
